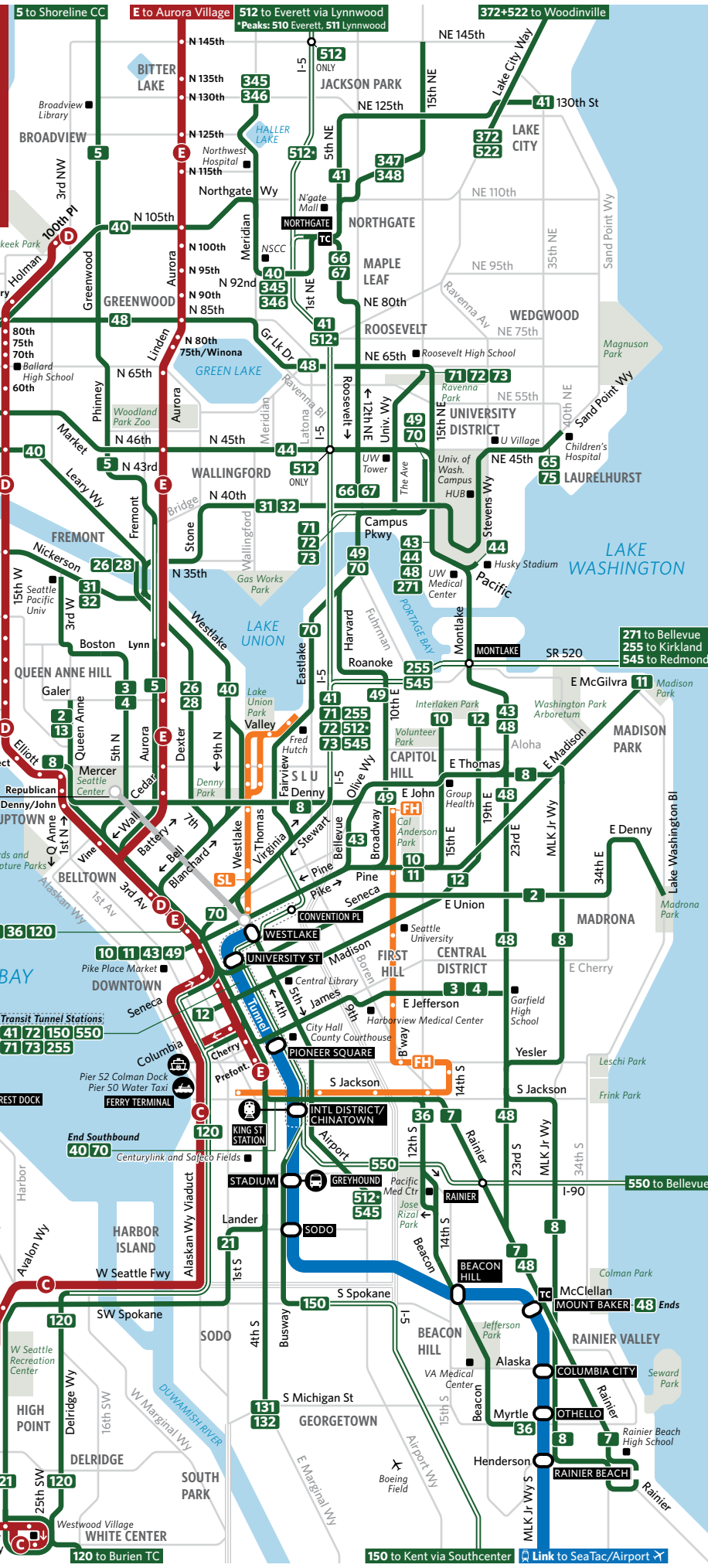


# Seattle EVERY 15 MINUTES (OR BETTER)

Frequent Transit Network



## Just show up and go!

This map shows you Seattle's network of frequent bus and rail lines running at least every 15 minutes (or better), Monday-Friday until 6 PM that will be in effect by September 2015. Most of them also run frequently on weekends and holidays, and late into the night.

### Central Link light rail

Every 15 MIN: 6 AM-midnight every day  
 Every 10 MIN: 8 AM-10 PM every day  
 Every 7.5 MIN: weekday peak hours

### RapidRide bus

Limited stops for a faster ride every day  
**C D** every 7.5-15 MIN, 6 AM-1 AM  
**E** every 10-15 MIN, 8 AM-8 PM  
 Less frequently at other times (24/7).

### Seattle Streetcar

**FH (First Hill)**  
 Monday-Saturday: 5 AM-1 AM  
 Sunday & Holiday: 10 AM-8 PM

### SL (South Lake Union)

Monday-Thursday: 6 AM-9 PM  
 Friday-Saturday: 6 AM-11 PM  
 Sunday & Holiday: 10 AM-7 PM

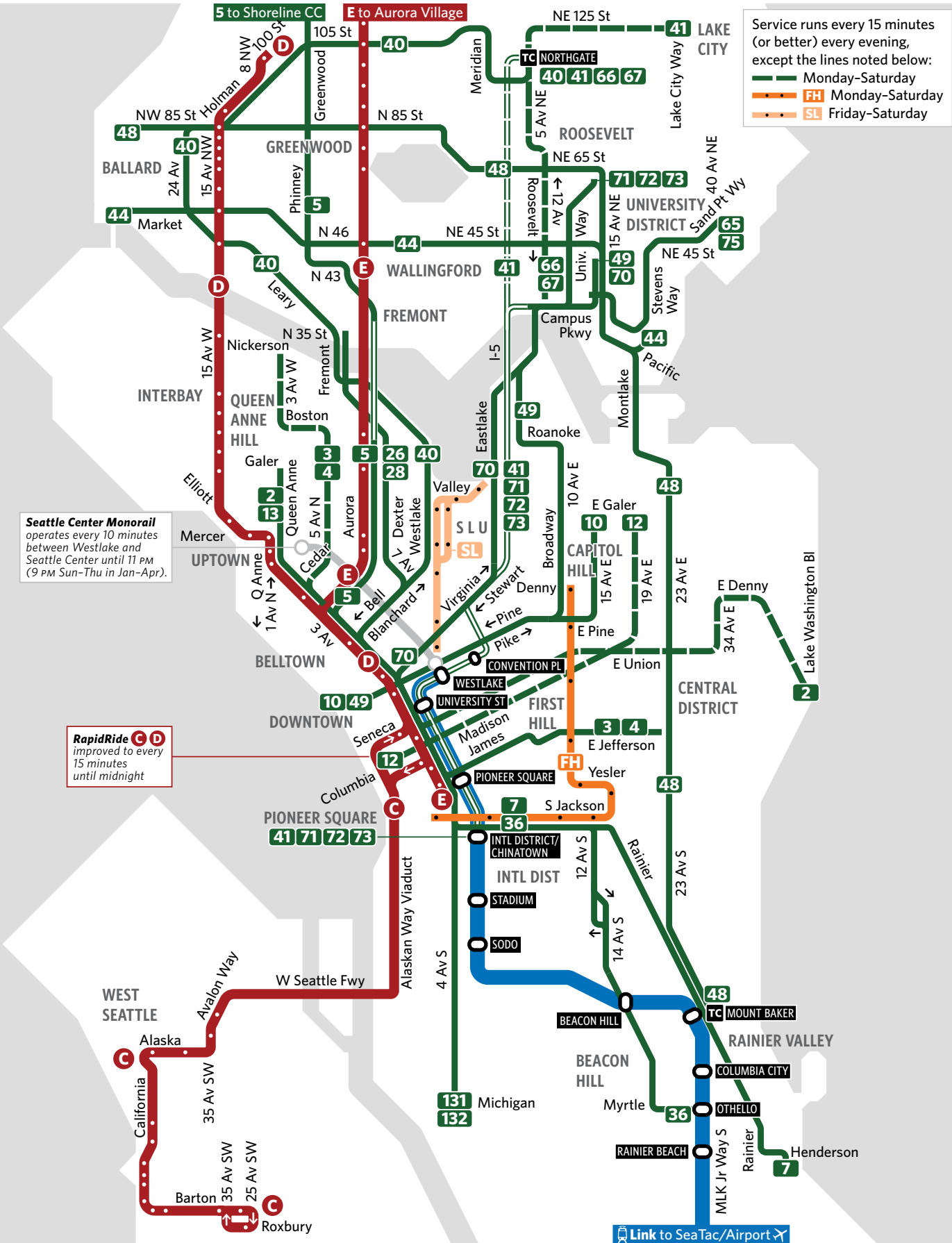

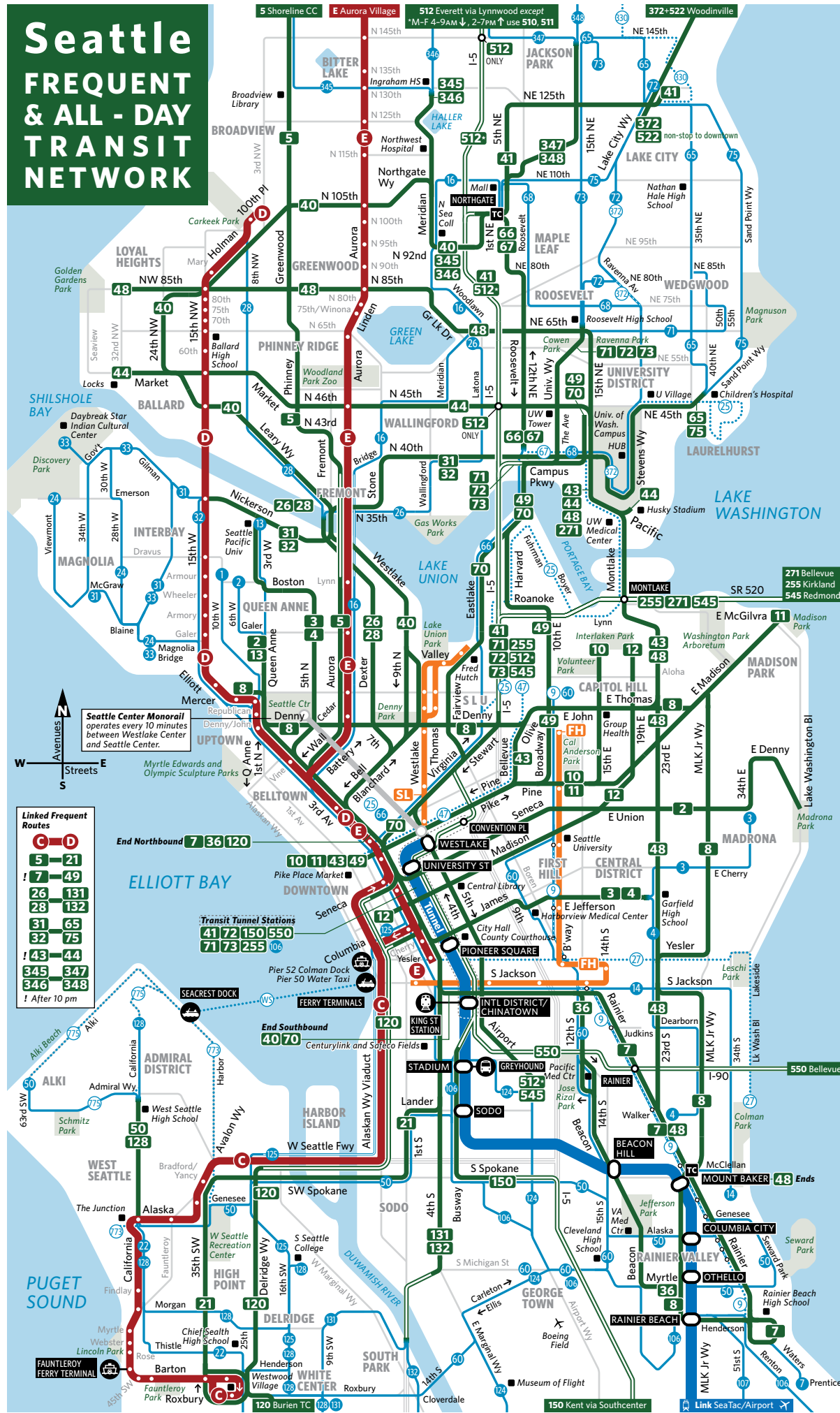

## Coming September 2015

This simplified map shows Seattle's network of frequent and all-day bus and rail lines effective September 2015. Improvements are funded by voter approved taxes collected by the city's Transportation Benefit District.

## Frequent Service

Service every 15 minutes or better, at least until 6 PM on weekdays and often later through the evening and on weekends.
