



UPDATED DOWNTOWN PARKING PERMIT PROGRAM

Available to all businesses within the Downtown Urban Center (DUC) zoning designation with a **current City business license** and **all Auburn residents** with a verified Auburn address.

DURATION OF PERMITS

1 month	6 months	12 months
	Eligible for a 10% discount in total fee if purchased; does not apply if requesting a permit fee reduction	Eligible for a 15% discount in total fee if purchased; does not apply if requesting a permit fee reduction

PLEASE NOTE: Renewal of permits must occur before or on the 21st day of the month that the permit expires in order to secure a renewal. Renewals must occur **IN PERSON** or **VIA PHONE CALL**. Persons who fail to apply for a permit renewal by this date will not be eligible for renewal of their permit and their parking space will be rented on a first-come, first-served basis. If the 21st day falls on a weekend day, the renewal must be conducted by 5:00 p.m. the following Monday.

*PERMIT FEE REDUCTION OPPORTUNITY

Permit applicants may be eligible for a 50% reduction in the total parking permit amount for eligible downtown permit parking locations. In order to qualify for this reduction, an applicant must submit a city required form and demonstrate a minimum of one (1) of the following:

- Be previously certified as a qualifying Auburn resident under the provisions of Chapter 13.24 (Utility Rate Exemptions) of the Auburn City Code; OR
- Be a disabled Auburn resident that can provide evidence of one (1) or more of the following documents:
 - Current King County Metro Regional reduced fare permit.
 - Certification from the Veterans Administration of a disability of at least 40 percent.
 - Valid Medicare card issued by the Social Security Administration.
 - Valid Regional ADA para-transit card issued by King County Metro or Pierce Transit or Sound Transit.
 - Current participation in a vocational career program through the Washington State Individual Education Program.
 - Medically disabled as certified by a physician, psychiatrist, psychologist, physician's assistant, advanced registered nurse practitioner or audiologist, licensed in the State of Washington.
